Vector (Dxf/Dwg) data can be purchased for 12/18/24 or 30 month periods. The data can be used internally as much as you wish during the relevant license period. Once the license period expires the data must be re-purchased if you want to continue to use.	Vector (Dxf/Dwg) or raster (TIFF) data can be purchased for 12 month periods only. The data can be used internally as much as you wish during the 12 month license period but must be re-purchased after 12 months if you want to continue to use.	PMCL is purchased on an annual basis and cost is dependent on number of offices. Copies can be used in professional or commercial services and can feature in promotional materials such as brochures and web pages.

Once the usage period expires, PDB enables you to archive a copy of the data for a period of up to 13 years for professional indemnity purposes. Any paper copies of the mapping derived from the data can also be archived ad infinitum along with any paper drawings containing map data.	Once the usage period expires, all digital copies of map data must be deleted and any drawings stored electronically that contain OS map data must also be deleted. Any paper copies of the mapping may be stored ad infinitum as can any paper drawings containing map data.	Paper copies can be archived ad infinitum.

Data supplied under PDB can be shared with up to 40 contractors without the contractors needing to sign any additional licenses.	Data supplied under IBU can be shared with as many contractors as you wish but each contractor must complete and sign a contractor license stating that the data will be destroyed at the end of the license period. The contractor must ensure that this happens and is liable if not.	Copies made using PMCL can be shared internally and externally as part of customers' business use. The copies cannot be sold on or included in a publication for which a charge is levied as this comes under a separate publishing license (telephone 0870 890 3730 for details about this).
